Pesach Fulfilled



Pesach was always about remembrance. But when Messiah took the bread and the cup, He fulfilled it—and everything changed.

THEN

- Remembering deliverance from Egypt
- Looking back at what God did
- A pattern of remembrance

NOW

- Revealing a greater deliverance in Christ
- Living from what has been accomplished
- A life transformed by His finished work

"This is My body." "This is My blood." What was once anticipated has now been given.

We no longer remember at a distance— we live in what He has done.

You Have Come to Zion



Sinai was a moment to be witnessed. Zion is a life to be inhabited.

ZION

- Internal reality
- City of the living God
- The Spirit within
- A life we now live

3 Pentecost Fulfilled

Now Lived From



When the Spirit was poured out at Shavuot (Acts 2), it was not another Sinai—it was the fulfillment.

- Not law written on stone → But life written within
- Not a voice from a distance → But the Spirit dwelling in us
- Not a moment to return to → But a reality to live from

Pentecost is no longer something we move toward. It is something we now live from.

The Omer is not about becoming enough. It is about becoming aware.

- We are loved because He first loved us. 1 John 4:19
- We walk in His obedience, not our own. Philippians 2:13

- We live under His reign—already established. Colossians 1:13
